
Vision Statement

A Story of Hope!

A woman came to the Center with an unexpected pregnancy in 2020. She stated that she, "didn't want to have a bunch of children and not be able to take care of them." She considered abortion to be the answer but after the ultrasound chose life for her unborn baby. We continued to be part of her story after two more pregnancies and births. She has been a single working mom throughout her parenting. Her pregnancy this year brought a devastating diagnosis of a genetic disorder. Specialists suggested an abortion as the best way forward but after receiving the years of support the BVPC offered through her multiple pregnancies, she chose to carry to term. After delivery, the diagnosis was found to be inaccurate, and her baby is a beautiful addition to her family.

Journey with a Client!

Early in 2024, we encountered a client from a foreign country who had experienced a miscarriage and was very fearful that her current pregnancy would end in the same manner. She and her husband had been trying to have a baby for many years and she didn't want to get her hopes up this time. We did an ultrasound and she was so relieved and overjoyed to tears when she saw the baby's heart beating. We were able to provide STI testing and help in finding a medical provider. Through our Bright Course Parenting Classes and discussions, many of her concerns and questions were answered. We were able to connect her with a visiting nurse program and with birthing classes from Janel Blackburn. We look forward to continuing this journey with her and are so grateful to be the hands of support for her.


Education

Group Parenting Education

Our parenting series helped **13** mothers and fathers develop long-term parenting plans, increasing self-sufficiency and deepening sense of community.

Conscious Discipline offers skills to transform everyday discipline issues into teachable moments, equipping children with the social-emotional and communication skills needed to self-regulate, resolve conflict and develop healthy behavior.

Circle of Security focuses on the developmental importance of attachment for every human being and relies on research using attachment theory.



Bright Course Lessons - Up to date and helpful video lessons on pregnancy, infancy, toddlers, parentings, and life skills. Clients watch classes, complete homework, and meet with a BVPC Client Advocate to discuss lesson content.

REAL Essentials Advance, is the country's leading relationship education curriculum. It is specifically designed to equip young people with the skills needed for combating challenges they face in adolescence. Lesson content captures the students attention through interactive activities and directs them toward positive decision making. The sexual health components of REAL Essentials Advance are SRA (Sexual Risk Avoidance) approved. All lessons are inclusive, evidence based and medically accurate.



Ever After is our annual middle school event that functions as a day retreat to point our young ladies to find their identity in Christ. 38 - 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students attended on April 6th 2024. During our last middle school event in the spring, a student who had been separated from her family and in foster care came to the event with a friend. She shared with her small group leader her story and that she wanted to be a part of this Christian community even if her parents didn't approve. With the help of an adult, she started attending a church near her foster family's home where she continued to find hope and a desire to know Jesus more.

There is a Way!

A young woman found herself pregnant without the support of the father. Despite facing many challenges, she was determined to parent her baby. Through this challenging first year of being a new single mom, she has received medical support and tools for parenting through our group parenting classes. She has found a sense of community and is thriving with her precious child.



A woman who begins to consider if she might be unexpectedly pregnant is highly likely to search for direction and understanding from the internet. In the next year we will begin a new marketing campaign to encourage these Millennials and Gen Zs to come to the Center and receive services and care that will empower her to make an informed decision.

We want to have a fighting chance to direct her to our doors for help. This will require a large amount of funds. Our strategy in 2025 will be to write grants to foundations to offset this new online marketing expense in our budget.

In the last three decades, taking a leap of faith has not been foreign for those in the leadership of the BVPC. With prayer and much guidance from surrounding pregnancy centers we are excited to witness God's discernment, provision, and protection as we step into this new opportunity to reach the women that are abortion determined with love and our vital services.
